

HOW TO READ YOUR SCORE REPORT

For Tests with Multiple-Choice Questions Only

Overview. Your score report provides information about your performance on the Minnesota Teacher Licensure ExaminationsSM (MTLESM). Your score report includes information about each subtest taken on the test date indicated and summary information about subtests passed to date.

Score Report. Your score report includes the test date, subtest(s) taken, your subtest score(s), and your passing status for each subtest.

Subtest Diagnostic Information. Diagnostic information is provided for all subtests taken on the test date indicated.

Performance indices are provided for each subarea. These indices are designed to help you understand your areas of strength or weakness. You do not pass individual subareas. Subarea indices should be interpreted with caution since different subareas contain different numbers of items. Subareas with a greater number of items have a greater overall impact on your total score.

Performance Indices Definitions

++++ You answered most of the items correctly.	++ You answered some of the items correctly.
+++ You answered many of the items correctly.	+ You answered few or none of the items correctly.

Passing Status Summary Report. This section lists each subtest you have passed to date and the date on which you passed it. Each subtest you have not yet taken will also be listed and will be noted as "Not Taken."

Detailed Performance Analysis. This section provides information about the number and percentage of multiple-choice questions answered correctly on each objective.
